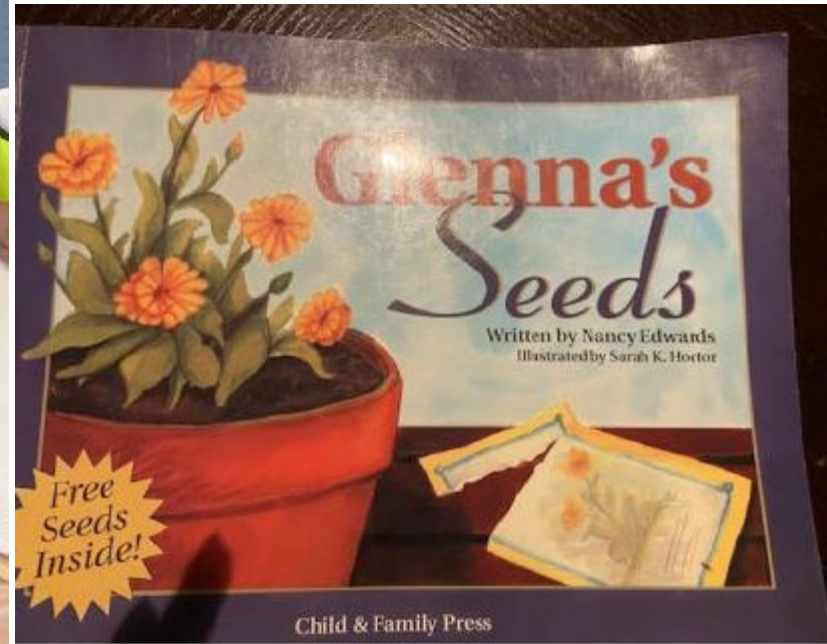

# Seeds that Fall

*MATTHEW 13, MARK 4, LUKE 8*

Jesus used to tell another story to make people understand God's message. It was about a man who sowed seed.

"One day a man went out with a bag of seed to sow," began Jesus. "Some of the seed he threw fell on a stony path, where birds flew down and ate it."



“Some of the seed fell on rough, rocky ground where there was hardly any soil. When the corn began to sprout into young plants, the strong sun dried them up and they died.”

“Some of the seed fell among weeds. As the young corn plants tried to grow, the weeds wrapped themselves around the plants and choked them.”

“But some seed fell on good ground. The young plants grew well and produced much corn.”

Jesus then explained this story to his followers.



“Some people are like the seed which fell on the stony path: they hear God’s message but choose not to believe it.”

“Other people are like the seed that fell on the rough, stony ground: they, too, hear God’s message but, when life becomes hard, they choose not to obey it.”

“And some people are like the seed that fell amongst the weeds: they hear their love of money and possessions blind them to God’s message.”



“But for people who are like the seed that fell on the good ground, they are blessed. They have heard God’s message. They understand that God’s Word is the truth, and they try every day to obey His laws.”
